The Vacaville Public Education Foundation (VPEF) Board is pleased to announce the recipients of Classroom Enrichment Grant awards for the 2011-2012 school year. We have allocated \$38,000 for these Classroom Enrichments Grants!! We received 78 grant requests totaling \$52,097; we greatly appreciate and respect the efforts of all those who submitted requests on behalf of their students.

We were able to fund all or part of 84 percent of grants eligible under our guidelines included in the application. The great news about this is that so many of our students (approximately 60%) are being touched by these enrichment grants—thank you for being our partner in delivering that for which we fundraise.

You can help us to continue to raise funds and even increase our fundraising capacity by letting students and parents know that these activities are funded by VPEF, sending letters to the editor, and providing the feedback in the evaluations.

At our Loop the Lagoon annual fundraiser, we offered an award of a classroom grant given in the name of the largest team to enter the Loop. The largest team was The Ramirez Family; they chose the Leader In Me, Character Building Program at Alamo to be funded in their name.
